Beverly Children's Learning Center



BCLC had outgrown its leased space in an office park, operating with insufficient storage, lack of indoor gross motor space and sinks in classrooms, and leaking windows. BCLC hoped to expand its programming to include additional age groups. BCLC purchased a former medical office building with space leased to two dentist practices, tenants that remain in place today and help BCLC support the debt service for the building. BCLC built out the space to contain infant/toddler, preschool and out of school time classrooms and enjoy a 1.9 acre site, located near schools, housing, with ample room for play space, pick up/drop off and parking.
