
Changes Made to HMLP to Better Serve Disabled and Elderly /

CEDAC and the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission (MRC) announce changes to the Home Modification Loan Program (HMLP) to ensure increased benefits to the populations it serves. HMLP, a state-funded loan program established in 1999, assists homeowners and small landlords to fund home accessibility improvements that allow disabled or elderly family members to remain in their own homes.
